Tainui Full Primary Uniform Policy

After consultation with the community and a phasing in process over 3 years all children will be expected to be wearing full uniform in 2017 - this year.

We believe that having a school uniform assists the children and community to develop a sense of identity with, and pride for their school. It also assists with the development of the TFPS Expectations.

All items can only be ordered from the School Office. In most cases it will take 48 hours for the items to be delivered to school. We will have order days every two weeks for the first term and less frequently after that.

Incorrect Uniform

Step 1 - Students who attend without wearing the correct uniform will be given a letter 1 Letter One for their parent/guardian and expected to be in correct uniform the following day. If this is not possible parents/guardians must contact the school office to ensure that further action is averted. Teachers please give students a chit to say that you have dealt with their uniform issue if they are not in correct uniform. Uniform Chit

Step 2 – Student is still not in correct uniform, or no contact with the school office has been made. Parents/guardians of the student concerned will be contacted directly via phone call and again in writing Letter 2 <u>Letter Two</u>. Parents will be asked to indicate when their child will be in the correct uniform in order to comply with the BOT policy. Failure to be in correct uniform within a time frame agreed with the Principal, (or avoidance of communicating with the school), will result in further action being taken. Teachers please give students a chit to say that you have dealt with their uniform issue if they are still not in correct uniform. Uniform Chit

Step 3 – Further action will be taken in order to comply with the BOT uniform policy. Depending on the circumstances and prior communication this could result in:

- Child being removed from school sporting teams, orchestra, choir, etc
- Exclusion from optional school activities like shows, sporting trips, discos, etc
- Family being invited to talk with the BOT about problems / concerns they have with the uniform

The uniform is to be worn with pride, and in a clean condition.

Marking or defacing the School Uniform is not acceptable and will be dealt with as a behavioural issue.

If boys are wearing long socks (black) as part of their uniform choice, these are to be pulled up under the knee.

Hats are to be worn in the manner they were designed for.

Students may wear black thermals underneath their school uniform.

Raincoats and Jackets

Children are able to wear any type of raincoat to and from school on wet days.

Physical Education Programmes and Sporting Events

Students involved in school sports teams will be required to wear the school polo shirt or sports shirts supplied (e.g. Rugby).

The school has an official school jacket, which is the only jacket that can be worn at both school and at sporting events.

The children will not be required to wear a separate uniform for classroom

Children may wear a separate shirt of their own choosing if participating in Physical Education or rough and tumble games.

Payments and Purchase Information

Uniform items can be ordered from the School office. Once we receive a bulk order we will then place an order through to NZ Uniforms.

At all times, uniform purchases can be made:

At the school office between 8:30am and 3:15 pm during term time.

All purchases are strictly cash on ordering, payment methods include

- Cash
- Automatic Payments that are in credit through money being deposited into school bank account
- Internet banking
- Work and Income

\$47.00	Polo Fleece (can choose to wear the fleece or the jacket or both)

\$24.00	Shorts (can wear these all year round if you choose too).

The following items should be majority black in colour and can be purchased anywhere. Black socks, Black shoes, Black sandals/jandals For Girls

Skort – is a pair of shorts with a fabric panel resembling a skirt covering the front The skort can be worn all year round – in the winter the girls can choose to put black tights under the skort. They also have the choice of wearing the uniform pants or the uniform shorts.
